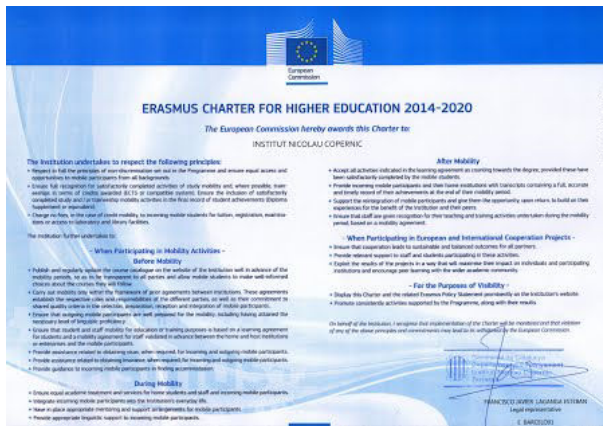

Who will assist me while I'm abroad?

You will have a school tutor assigned to you, as well as a company mentor that will assist you in all the process. They will both control your learning process



How much is it going to cost me?

The Erasmus Program offers grants to help with mobility expenses. The grant depends on the country you will go and the course you are studying.



What language will I need to communicate with the company staff?

A good level of English is recommended or a good level of the language of the host country.



What about the follow-up of the classes?

You will be a minimum of two months doing internships at the company. An online tracking of the classes is required during the stay abroad



What will my grades be?

FCT evaluation is identical to the one done when you do the internships in Catalan companies

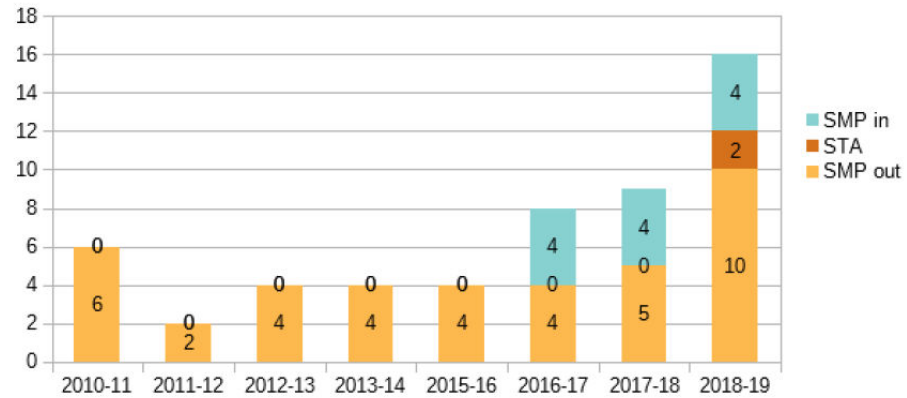

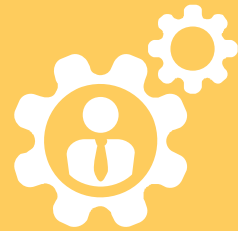

Requirements

What are the **requisites** to participate?

Student

Be enrolled in INS Nicolau Copèrnic during the academic course in which you benefit from the mobility.

Favorable Report

Students must have a favorable report from their tutor.

Be “Clean”

Students must have obtained at least 50% of the credits required to obtain the corresponding diploma, in addition to fulfilling the requisites required to be able to complete the FCT.



Age

You must be 18 years or older before the start of the stay.

Language

To prove a minimum level of B1 for the language of the country of destination or the language established by the host organization.

Nationality

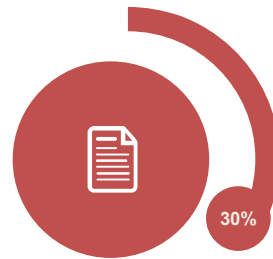
Having a nationality of one of the participating countries in ERAMUS +.

Selection Criteria



Language Level

It will value with a maximum of 40 points depending on your level of English or the language of the host country.



Academic Results

The academic record will be valued over a total of 30 points.

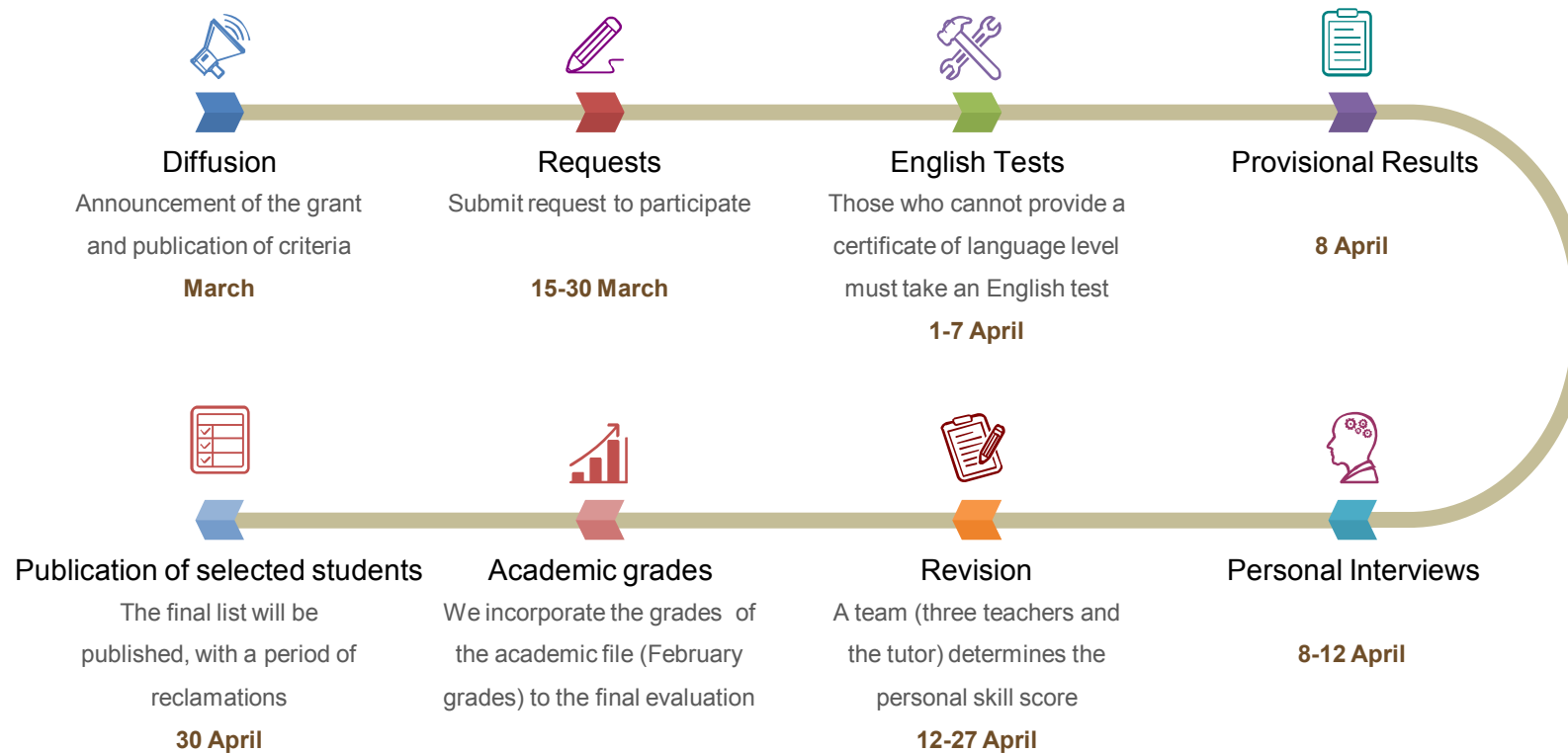


Personal skills

It will be valued with a maximum of 30 points taking into account competences such as the ability to adapt to the environment, autonomy, ability to solve problems and motivation.

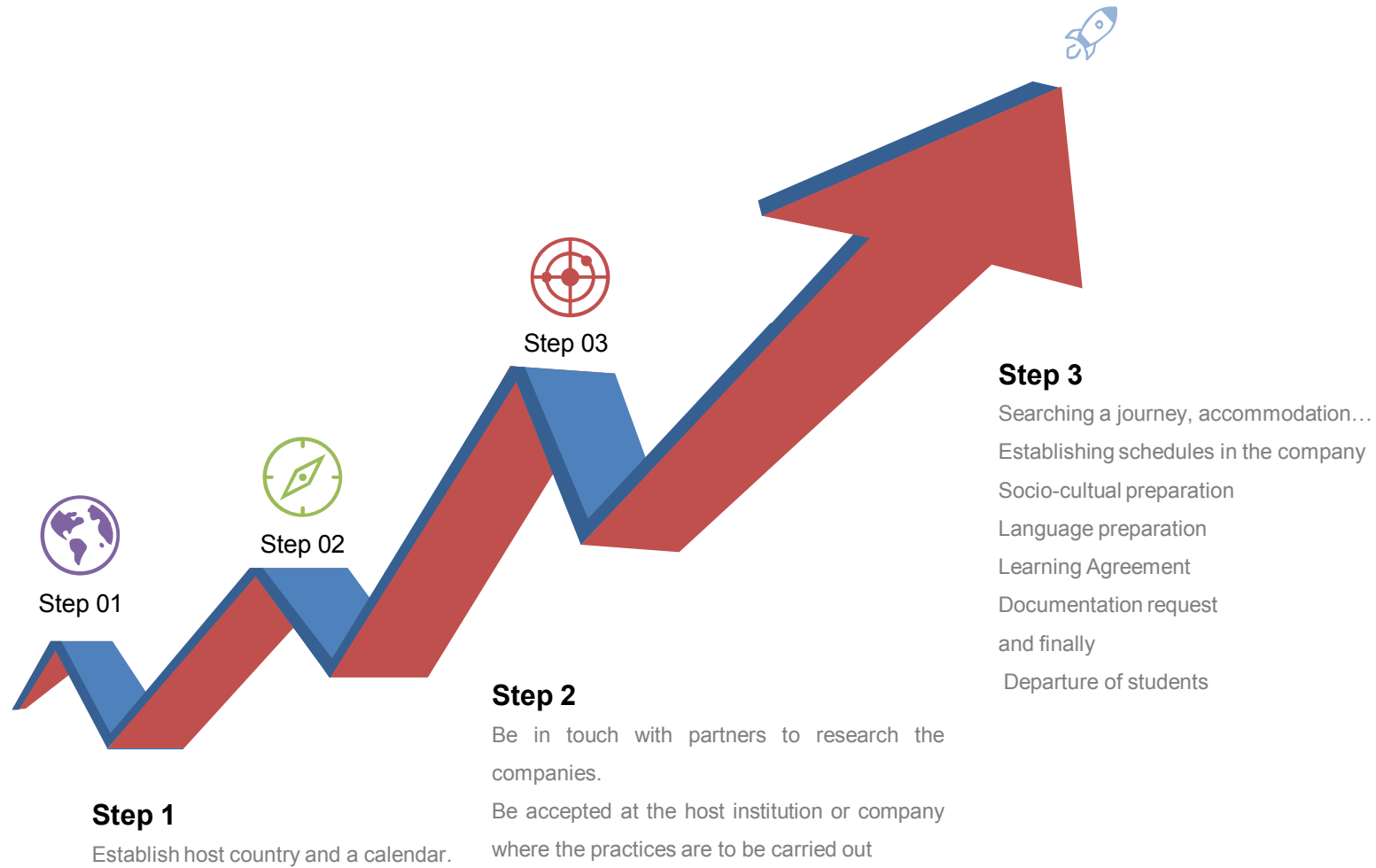
